Activity/Project Description:

- ➤ Teacher uses flashcards and audio recordings to introduce students to Dee Ni vocabulary and phrases
- > Students are assigned to a partner/small group
- > Students use instructions, list, map, and budget to plan their "How to Make" project. Students plan their trip to the market by locating/predicting location of items on their list, and getting their money together
- > 3rd graders assist 2nd graders with the shopping trip using, "you are getting hot", "you are getting cold" phrases
- > 3rd graders continue to assist as groups learn/demonstrate their project
- When demonstrations are finished, students can eat the results
