## Activity/ Project Description:

$>$ Grades K-5 contribute student artwork \& photographs to the creation of a 12 month calendar. Each month is assigned one of the "cultural universals", and this serves as a theme for the month's artwork/photography. The calendar has information about district holidays, important tribal \& community events, seasonal activities, gathering \& preparing etc.
$>4^{\text {th }}$ graders assemble images and create calendar layout using appropriate software
> Calendar is printed and copies are given to community businesses, organizations, individuals, etc. This would be a great Fall fundraiser prior to Christmas.
$>$ Monthly newsletter with school \& sports information published by $5^{\text {th }}$ grade.
$>$ Each month should include vocabulary and phrases to learn related to season \& theme.
