After completing the lesson, Students and/or Instructors will be able to:

- 1. Pronounce Dee Ni words containing "vowel" sounds: au, ay, gh, oy
- 2. Understand meaning of above words and translate simple phrases described in "phrases" section.

Activity/Project Description:

Dee Ni practical alphabet is taught to the class as a group using flashcards; specifically initial group of Dee-Ni "vowel" sounds: au, ay, gh, oy. The Dee Ni alphabet sounds may be combined with regular alphabet instruction, or taught in isolation, as per instructor preferences.

Optional

Create a coloring book/illustrated storybook. Each page would contain a phrase, as described in the phrases section of the "Lesson Objective Components". This activity could be done by the classroom instructor, by the students, or a collaborative effort.
