After completing the lesson, Students and/or Instructors will be able to:

- 1. Pronounce Dee Ni words containing "glottalized" sounds: ch', k', ts', kr', tr'
- 2. Understand meaning of above words and translate simple phrases described in "phrases" section
- 3. Increase confidence pronouncing sounds from previous lesson; reinforce awareness of translations of words and phrases from lesson 1.

Activity/Project Description:

- Dee Ni practical alphabet is taught to the class as a group using flashcards. Emphasis is placed on <u>glottalized</u> sounds: ch', k', ts', kr', tr'. Reinforce sounds from prior lesson "vowel" sounds: au, ay, oy. Dee Ni alphabet sounds may be combined with regular alphabet instruction, or taught in isolation, as per instructor preferences.
- ➤ Build on activity HK.01.02 Wee-ya guu-'i (Word Worm) with newly introduced glottalization vocabulary.
- ➤ *Optional* Create a coloring book/illustrated storybook. Each page would contain a phrase, as described in the phrases section of the "Lesson Objective Components". This activity could be done by the classroom instructor, by the students, or a collaborative effort.
