# Activity/Project Description:

- Students study and learn vocabulary words, focusing on concept of negation (like/do not like)
- Students use vocabulary cards to construct sentences/lines from the story, and copy words onto paper
- Students can re-create the story in book form using their own illustrations, and/or use the translation as a script for a skit. Students use art supplies to create props listed in materials list
- Skit is performed in association with school-wide Dr Seuss week activities could later be performed in a talent show and/or carnival
- Students could practice Table Talk lessons by preparing/eating tasty green eggs and ham (eggs with green food coloring, or pesto works best)
