

Salmon Life Cycle Skit

- 1 Narrator
- 12 Fish
- 12 Home Stream
- 12 River
- 12 Ocean

Narrator: "The salmon eggs begin in the home stream"

The eggs are hanging out in the home stream without moving around

Home Stream: "Gvmp yan-li~"

Narrator: "Salmon eggs they are" [short pause] "Then the salmon hatch"

The eggs switch into fingerlings, place eggs into the bucket, and travel out to the river.

Narrator: "The fingerlings swim downriver to the ocean"

The fingerlings swim through the river.

River: "Lhuk mvsh-xee-ye' yan-li~"

Narrator: "Salmon fingerlings they are"

The fingerlings continue to and arrive at the ocean.

Narrator: "They grow into adult salmon in the ocean."

The fingerlings switch to big fish and swim around in the ocean

Ocean: "Luu-k'e yan-li~"

Narrator: "Salmon they are" [short pause] "Once it's spring again the salmon swim back upriver to their home stream"

The spring salmon go back out to the river where they stop to say . . .

Fish: "Dan-dee-ni naa-ghit-li~"

Narrator: "Spring Salmon we are"

The spring salmon continue back upriver to their home stream and remove an egg from the bucket.

Narrator: “Once the spring salmon arrive at their home stream they lay their eggs.”

The spring salmon toss their eggs onto the ground.

Narrator: “Hat-dvn cha’ tes-ya. Then it goes again.”

All students gather to take a bow and exit.
